The TLSB cultural programme is an opportunity for local and international artists from all disciplines and ages to apply with proposals for potential artwork to be founded on the Lagoon.



International Programme: Open call for artists, major sculpture commission

A call for initial proposals for a major sculpture to be sighted within the footprint of the Tidal Lagoon Swansea Bay.

- The call is open to international and UK artists
- All types of sculptures will be considered, the choice of material is open
- Two of the concept proposals will be shortlisted and will each receive a budget of £10,000 to enable further development of the proposal
- The artwork should interact with the ambitions and significance of the Tidal Lagoon Swansea Bay
- The shortlist for the commissions will be announced at The Hay Festival May 2014, entries will be judged on impact, composition, originality, creativity and technical ability
- Deadline for proposal submissions will be 8th May 2014

Welsh Programme: Open call for artists, multi-disciplinary commission

A call for initial proposals for a multi-disciplined artwork to be sighted in or on the Tidal Lagoon Swansea Bay.

- The call is open to Welsh based artists
- All kinds of art will be considered: sound, video, poetry, writings, light installations, etc.
- The artwork should interact with the ambitions and significance of the Tidal Lagoon Swansea Bay
- Three concept proposals will be shortlisted and each will receive a budget of of £5,000 to enable further development of the proposal
- The deadline for proposals will be 5th October 2014
- The shortlist will be announced at the Dylan Thomas Festival October 2014
